LOCKE'S SECOND TREATISE ON GOVERNMENT:

- Natural Rights: Life, Liberty & Property which existed before government
- Government power is derived from consent of the governed
- Government exists to defend natural rights
- Governments can be replaced if they fail to secure rights or usurp them

BRITISH LIBERTY

Why did it start to go bad?

- -English Constitution (There wasn't one really...)
 - Collection of laws, charters and tradition that was thought to protect the liberties of British subjects.
 - Small violations of liberties by the British government snowballed (You can't get a little bit pregnant)











MODELS OF DEMOCRACY

PARTICIPATORY/DIRECT DEMOCRACY

a model of democracy in which citizens have the power to decide directly on policy and politicians are responsible for implementing those policy decisions.

EXAMPLES: Town hall meetings; State ballot initiatives (Proposal 3)

ELITE

a small number of people, usually those who are wealthy or well-educated, influence political decision-making

EXAMPLES: State legislatures selecting senators
